STEP 3

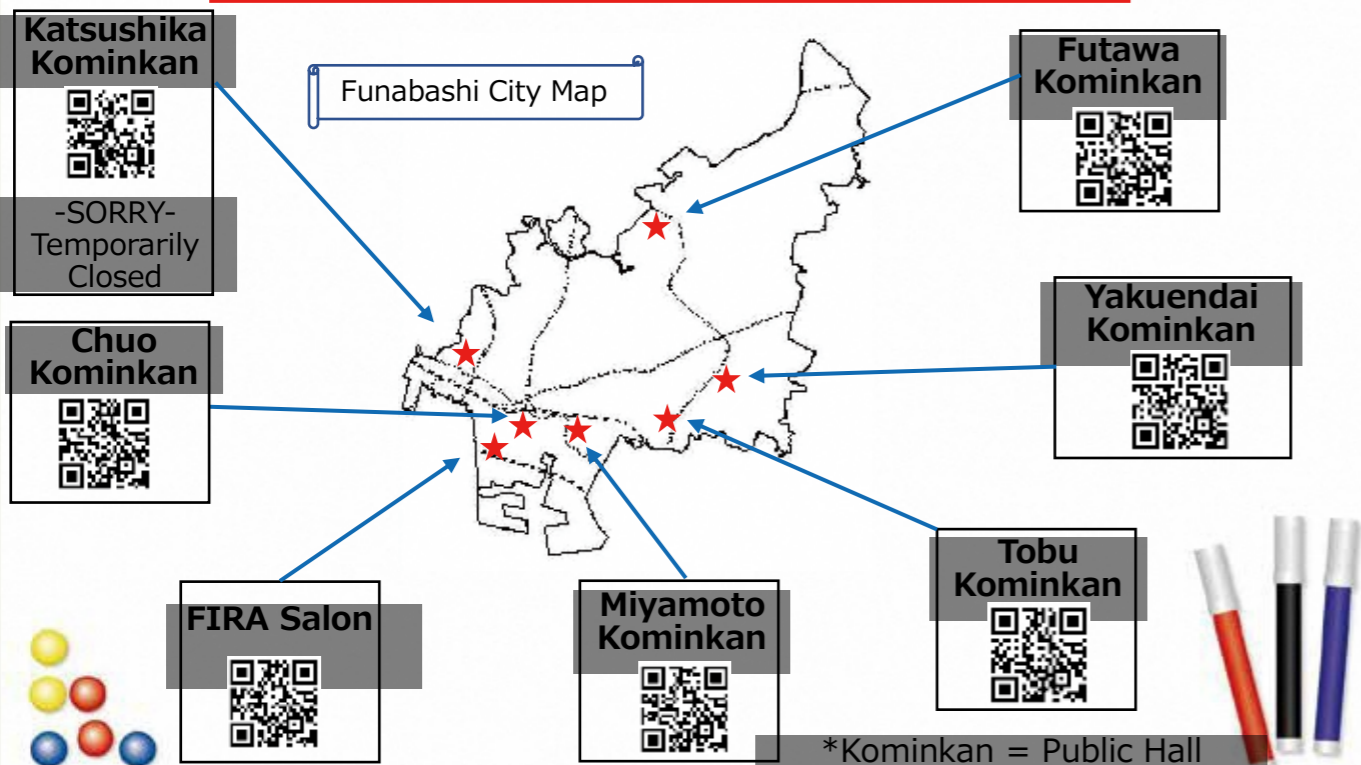
You will receive the completion mail and information of your class.

Japanese Class

★Annual membership fee: 2000 yen
Fee: 2000 yen/ term per class
Textbook: 2500 yen

- There are three terms in a year.(Term 1: May – July, Term 2: September- November, and Term 3: January – March)

- The course offers lessons once a week, total 10 - 12 lessons for 3 months. 2 hours/ lesson
